## **PURPOSE**

### **GRANTS**

The primary goal of the Foundation will be to award grants that assist, recognize, promote, and fund extra-curricular participation by high school students in athletic and fine arts programs. 

## MSHSL FOUNDATION Grand Opportunities

The MSHSL Foundation, established in 2007, aims to support high school students' participation in extracurricular activities. The 2023-2024 grant focus includes leadership initiatives, health and safety programs, and transportation solutions that reduce barriers, with restrictions on certain items, such as awards, banquets, capital expenditures, and technological devices, as outlined in the grant request categories and instructions.



#### HENNEPIN COUNTY YOUTH BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL GRANTS



The Hennepin County Baseball & Softball grant programs, administered by the Minnesota Twins Community Fund staff, offer financial support for youth programs' capital projects and equipment needs. The grants, ranging from \$5,000 to \$100,000, are available to government agencies and nonprofits, with a preference for projects that foster partnerships and demonstrate sustainability, while applicants must start their projects within nine months of receiving the grant.



# TWIN CITIES PUNKERS Lunders TWIN CITIES

Twin Cities Dunkers, an organization celebrating sports achievements, honors local individuals and welcomes sports and entertainment figures to the Twin Cities. Their Dunkers Fund supports 14 high school athletic programs by providing funds for the purchase of athletic equipment through donations to The Minneapolis Foundation-Dunkers Fund.

# HENNEPIN COUNTY GRANT

The Hennepin County Youth Activities Grants, initiated in 2009, distributes over \$31.2 million to local government units within Hennepin County, supporting youth access to activities through water safety, sports, and arts/music initiatives. Funded by the Twins ballpark sales tax, the program offers grants for facility improvements, play spaces, sports equipment, and registration fees, with application periods in the fall and spring each year, exclusively for eligible Local Government Units such as park systems, cities, public school districts, and watershed districts in Hennepin County.


